

Sierra Economic Development Corporation (SEDCorp) Board Vacancy

The Sierra Economic Development Corporation (SEDCorp) Board is seeking to fill one At Large seat: a position for a representative of institutions of post-secondary education, workforce development groups, labor groups or Executive Directors of Chambers of Commerce.

Candidate must be knowledgeable of the problems and issues existing in their areas and help define regional goals to generate private and public investment to develop employment opportunities for the unemployed and underemployed.

SEDCorp is a non-profit corporation organized under the provisions of section 501(c)(4) of the IRS code established in 1969 through a Joint Powers Agreement between the counties of El Dorado, Placer, Nevada and Sierra. The Board members represent both the public jurisdictions and the primary economic sectors of the region. SEDCorp is involved in a wide spectrum of activities to support business and job development including small business lending, entrepreneurship training, extension of broadband services, and promotion of “green” technologies. Though we receive a small part of our annual operating budget from our member jurisdictions, the majority of our funding comes from a variety of public and private grant sources and service contracts.

The SEDCorp Board primarily meets monthly (except January and July) on the first Wednesday of the month, from 1:00pm-3:00pm at the SEDCorp office in Auburn; at least one meeting per quarter is held in one of the member jurisdictions.

The three-year term will begin January 1, 2012 and end Dec. 31, 2015. The representative has the option to renew additional terms.
